United Way of San Diego County

- Issues with volunteers
 - Signing up/not showing up
 - Offensive language/behavior
 - Work not up to standards
- Communication is key always!
- Set policies in writing



• Example: 2 warnings then a 3rd time means termination

Keeping Volunteers Engaged





- Email list
 - Keep them informed of your work
 - Send photos & impact stats from that day
 - Send success stories
 - Alert them to upcoming events
 - Alert them to new projects/opportunities
- Facebook Group
 - Have an admin to approve of posts

Volunteer Appreciation



- Welcome them when they are on-site (smile & say hi)
- Decorate during volunteer appreciation week
 - April 14-20, 2024
- Written shout-outs from staff
- Occasional pizza parties, ice cream socials (anything with food!)
- Get to know them as people
